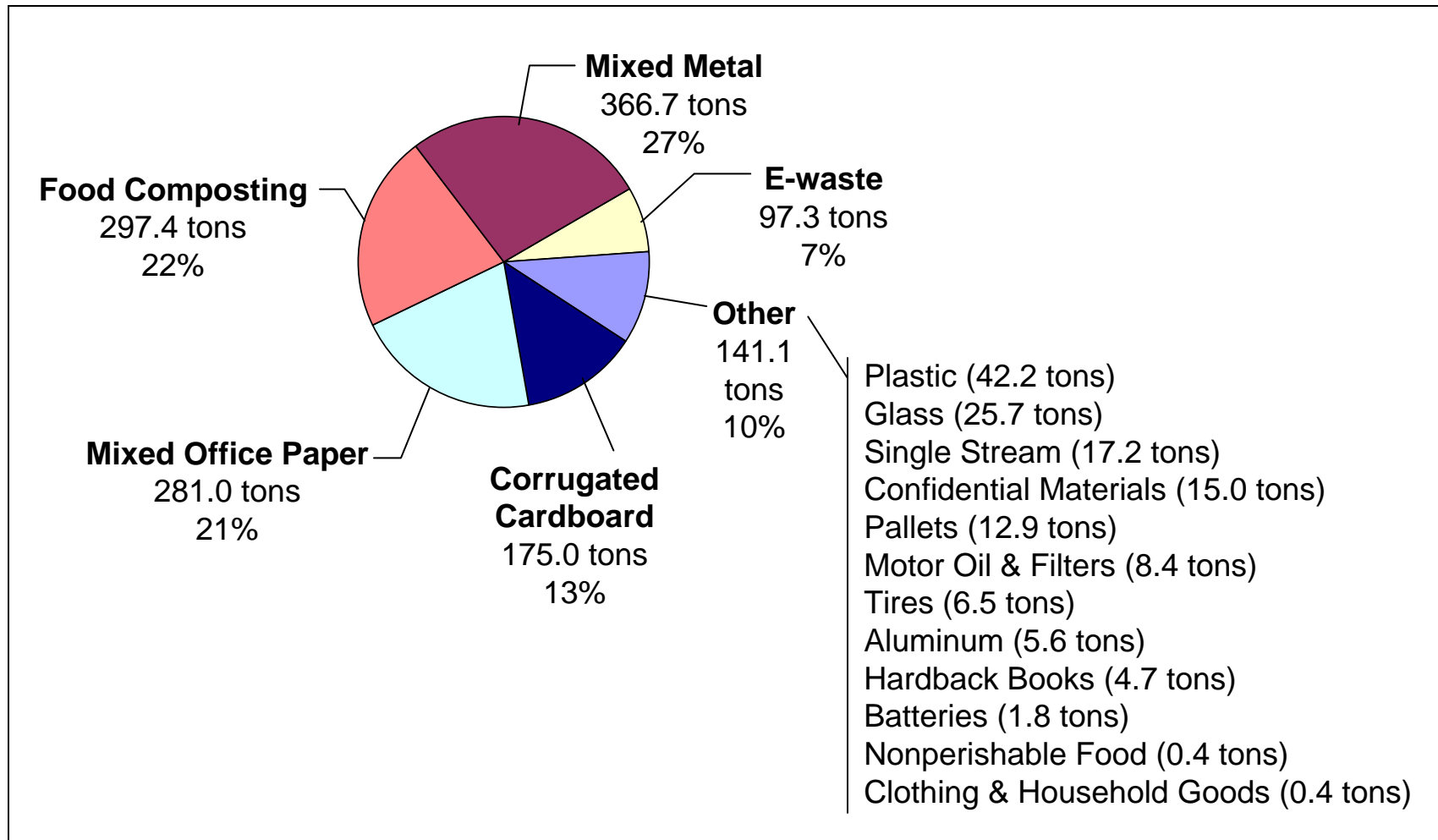


Georgia Tech Waste Diversion 2010
